









### FEMA'S NATIONWIDE COASTAL RE-MAPPING PROJECT



#### POST-PRELIMINARY MAPPING PROCESS





## 90-DAY APPEAL PERIOD FOR A PRELIMINARY FIRM

- The addition/modification of BFEs/base flood depths or any change in SFHA boundary, or zone designation requires a statutory 90-day appeal period and the fulfillment of the additional due process notification requirements outlined in the NFIP regulations Title 44, Chapter I, Section 67 (44CFR67)
- Anyone can submit (via the community official)
- Feedback inside of 90-day appeal period.


#### FEMA'S APPEAL PROCESS



#### TYPICAL SUBMITTALS

- Map corrections (Typical Comments)
  - Road names, flooding source names, Community Boundaries or other base map features
- New or updated flood hazard information (Typical Appeals)
  - Issues with the BFE
  - New Topographic Data
  - Revised Coastal Flood Hazard Analysis
  - Revised Floodplain, Zone, or Floodway Boundaries

## FEMA RIX'S EXPERIENCE WITH "SUBMITTALS"

- Counties made Submittals to FEMA RIX during their Appeal Period
- FEMA evaluates each submittal for compliance with 44CFR67.4
  - Sort Comments from Appeals
- FEMA Responds by letter to the community (and resident)
  - Coordinating with the community & community's engineer
  - Sometimes Additional Data is requested
- Active Community Coordination via email & meetings




